



# Barwick Clay Shoot Presents, Clay Shooting Holiday To Portugal



## Travel Information

### Outbound

So, now you are ready for off!

Don't forget, you need the following documentation.

Shotgun Certificate, Import/Export License, Invitation From The Shooting Club, Firearms In Transit Form, Flight Voucher, Money, Oh! And Your Passport!!!

On arrival at the airport, find the easyJet check-in area and proceed to the assistance lane. At this point you will need all your documentation to hand. You will be asked to transfer the information on your declaration form, onto a 4 copy NCR document.

Once checked in, please follow the directions of the check-in staff, who will advise on where to leave your guns. After that, it will be just like any other flight.

On arrival at Faro, again, just like any other flight, go through passport control and into baggage claim to pick up your normal suitcase/bags.

Your gun cases should be taken to the lost property/Police office, which is located to the left of the exit. You should just note that, there have been occasions when the baggage handlers have put the guns on the carousel with the normal baggage, so be aware.

In either situation, you need to declare your guns and produce all your paperwork. This is usually quite straight forward and you will be out in no time.

Exit onto the main concourse and turn left. If you are taking the transfer service, watch out for signs held by reps on your way out, they will guide you to your transport.

If you have chosen hire cars from the airport, the larger operators are located outside the main building to the right. Several smaller operators are located in car park 4 which is to the left.

After collecting your car, head for the exit road N125-10 and follow the signs for IC4 or N125 Loulé/Portimão West. Stay on the N125 to avoid toll charges. When you see a garden centre on the left (VIPLANT ALGARVE GARDEN) turn left at the roundabout just after it. This is Av. Vilamoura XXI and takes you directly into the resort.

## **Return**

Follow the N125 back towards Faro and turn right to the airport. Follow the car rental return instructions if you have a hire car. Transfers will drop you off directly outside the main terminal building.

All check-in desks are to the right of the main terminal. For those with guns, you must report to the Police office. This is located just outside the arrivals area, so turn left and go pretty much as far as you can, the Police office is on the right-hand side.

You will need to produce all your paperwork again and the guns will be checked. After this, proceed to the check-in area, locate EasyJet and again, go to the assistance lane. Your paperwork will be checked again, normal bags will be put through as normal, follow the instructions for the gun drop off. Once this is completed, again, it will be a normal flight.

On arrival back at Manchester, go through all the normal passport control and baggage claim. The guns will be brought to the customs checkpoint by security. Yes, you guessed it, paperwork checks again. Once this is completed, you are on your way.

We hope we have covered everything here, however, sometime there can be a spanner in the works. Don't panic, most things can be sorted quite easily.
